Deposit: Compaction, colour, composition, particle size, inclusions, thickness and extent, comments, method & conditions	<u>LIGHT RED (2.5YR 6/6), VERY LOOSE DEPOSIT CONSISTING OF FINE (medium coarse sand) to 121K particle sizes (fine gravel-sized lumps of clayey sand and mud), inclusions: flint, bones, burned wood, brick-fragments</u> <u>The thickness increases from few cm at SW of A2 to considerable thickness of more than 80cm at the E-section of A2 (and even increasing in thickness towards South adjacent E-Section).</u> <u>General ^{surface} inclination sloping from NE to SW, well visible in the working section (cf. photos).</u> <u>The section showed various alternating layers of sand and 121K particle sizes following the general surface inclination of the deposit.</u>
